A Step Forward

Impossible-Take a Child to School

Bringing positive and prominent changes in the project schools under the TACS project being implemented in Districts of Bahawalnager and Rajanpur with the financial support from British Council, Mojaz Foundation further strengthened the role of Mohallah Committees by facilitating them devising social action projects (SAP) for project schools. The SAPs's focus is on the provision of missing facilities so as to encourage enrollment and retention.

The Head Teacher, Government Primary School 2/FW (old) expressed;

“The school does not have a boundary wall which allows the cattle and dogs to enter the premises creating an insecure and unhealthy learning environment as well as a reason of distraction for the students.”

This crucial requirement led the members of the MC to the Deputy District Officer, Education who assisted them in the proper utilization of the non-salary budget. Hence, the construction of the boundary wall was initiated in the month of January and eventually completed before the end of the quarter.
