



## Outlook of Mojaz Activities

The COVID-19 pandemic has spread rapidly across the globe, causing localized clusters and outbreaks of disease in many countries. The World Health Organization (WHO) has declared Corona virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) a pandemic. The Coronavirus has hit badly almost all the areas of country.

MF's first response to Covid-19 was based on government's guidelines for maintaining social distance. Our staff was advised to work from home. Only the few who were considered important to attend the office were allowed, generally the admin staff. The staff was in particular advised to keep contact with their colleagues via whatsapp, zoom and skype. Those who were involved in field activities were also stopped from going to the field and were advised to divert their focus towards documentation and creating whatsapp groups with the district government, other NGOs and with their activists, volunteers and VO members for sharing necessary updates.

## Highlights of Activities

In Bahawalnagar, our Muhallah committee has raised funds and distributed food ration, and facemasks & sanitizers to deserving families in Tehsil Chistian.

In Narowal, our mobile vans equipped with loud speaker are making sure that the messages on protection from the COVID-19 are reaching out to the maximum population in the district. We have signed an agreement with HUBCO to provide 1000 hygiene kits in the district.

In Muzaffargarh our team is active in awareness raising activities. Meetings are held on regular basis with the district government for better coordination and planning. Assessment is being carried out on the situation in our field areas to design programs and projects.

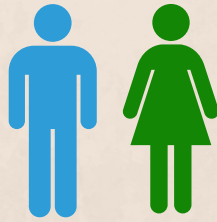


## Registration of Needy Families
